Proposition 6

Texas Water Fund

Support Sufficient Water Supply During a Drought

Proposition 6 will help support the development of new water supplies to meet the needs of our growing population, especially during an extended drought.

Promote Water Conservation

Proposition 6 will help repair and replace water infrastructure such as leaky pipes and support conservation awareness.

Help Local Communities and the Texas Economy

Proposition 6 will help expand water and wastewater infrastructure in local communities to preserve Texas' vibrant economy.



Proposition 7

Texas Energy Fund

Strengthen Reliability in Extreme Weather

Proposition 7 will help electric generation facilities modernize and weatherize so that they are resilient and continue to operate despite extreme weather.

Protect Texas Consumers

By increasing the supply of flexible generation, Proposition 7 will help protect Texans from further increases to their electricity bills by reducing the frequency of expensive shortage events.

Expand the Texas Energy Grid

Proposition 7 will help create new and robust energy infrastructure, leading to a larger supply of electricity whenever Texans need it.



Proposition 8

Texas Broadband Infrastructure Fund

Encourage Smart Fiscal and Economic Policy

Proposition 8 will help maximize state and federal dollars and drive corporate and private investment across Texas, leading to the creation of new, good-paying jobs.

Close the Digital Divide

Proposition 8 will help close the digital divide in Texas by helping unserved, underserved, rural, and remote areas gain expanded access to high-speed internet.

Enhance Public Safety

Proposition 8 will help provide critical upgrades for public safety and next generation 9-1-1 services to help keep Texans safe.
